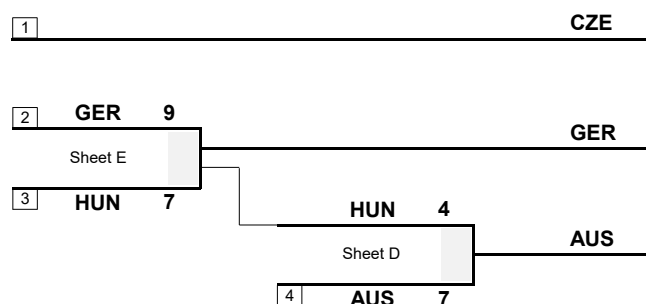

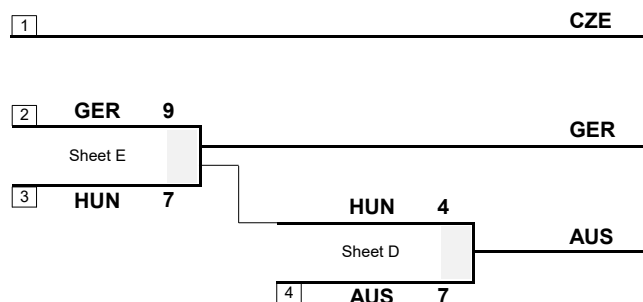

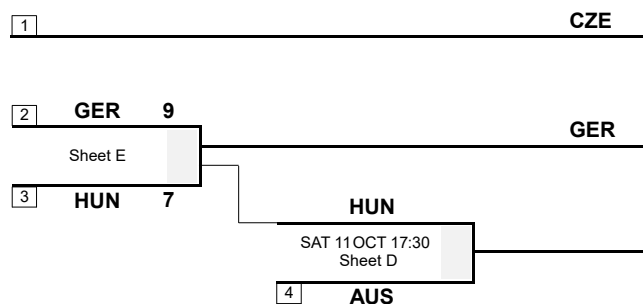

In the case where all counting LSDs are equal, the team ranked higher in the official World Curling World Ranking is ranked higher.
